**SHORT ANSWER**

1. Peter doesn't know anyone in Princeton, will miss his friends, and doesn't want change
2. Because Fudge puts trading stamps all over Tootsie
3. To sell them to Mrs. Muldour

5. Because Tootsie starts crawling
6. He fell off his bike after running into the bike rack

**LONG ANSWER**

1. They live in a house instead of an apartment; Peter has to make new friends and doesn't see Jimmy Fargo as much; Mr. Hatcher is at home or at the library instead of working at the ad agency; Peter can't play in Central Park, including on his rock; Sheila Tubman is not there; etc. (many answers are acceptable).
2. Mrs. Hildebrandt won't call Fudge by his name, so Fudge kicks her in the shin, climbs up a cabinet, and refuses to come down. Fudge calls her mean, and also calls her Rat Face.
