

SOLAR SYSTEM ALLITERATIONS

Alliteration is what happens when the words in a phrase or a sentence begin with the same letter and sound. Alliteration is used to make writing more interesting. It is also used to write tongue twisters. Here is an example of an alliteration using the words **SOLAR SYSTEM** and the beginning **S** sound:
